OUR APPROACH TO SOCIAL AND COMMUNITY IMPACT

Our Mission is to make a positive difference in the lives of those who work, bank, invest at Pioneer. For the fifth year in a row, Pioneer Bank was named one of the Top Workplaces in New Mexico by the Albuquerque Journal. We continue to be proud of the work Team Pioneer is doing growing our people inside the Bank.

Our primary focus in 2021 was growing loans and deposits. Total loan production increased to \$385.6 million. Our Roswell market generated \$152.0 million in loans, Las Cruces \$140.4 million, and loans in El Paso \$52.0 million. Much of this lending, \$168.5 million, was through participations with other community

banks generally not competing directly with us in our markets. Deposits in Roswell increased \$78.4 million to \$337.3 million at year-end while deposits in Las Cruces increased \$36.1 million to end the year at \$149.7 million. We wish to recognize our Las Cruces Advisory Board for their contribution to our success in Las Cruces.

In February 2021, we celebrated 120 years of building community. Team Pioneer, our philanthropic program, exemplifies who we have been, who we are, and who we strive to be. We are proud of the impact we are making on each other and our communities.






